

WHATCOM COUNTY OLD SETTLERS ASSOCIATION 2010 PARADE THEME

“VOLUNTEERS THROUGHOUT THE YEARS”

You are invited to participate in the Old Settlers Grand Parade on Saturday, July 24th at 11:00 am. All entrants will start at Ferndale High School and are asked to approach the site by traveling on Vista Dr. and turning on Shuksan St. to the registration booth in front of the cafeteria. Floats and Cars will be in the large parking lot. Horses will be placed in the back parking lot. OWNERS MUST KEEP THEIR HORSES OFF SCHOOL GRASS AND PRIVATE PROPERTY AND PROVIDE THEIR OWN POOPER SCOOPERS. We will attempt to place horse-drawn entries toward the front of the parade. Due to lack of space, we cannot provide a staging area. Judges will specifically be looking for entries that follow or incorporate this year's theme. FOR JUDGING, EACH ENTRY REQUIRES ITS OWN REGISTRATION FORM. IF YOU WANT TO BE JUDGES, BE THERE BY 9:45!

-All floats must be equipped with a fire extinguisher

-After reaching Pioneer Park, anyone letting people off floats should do so on Third Ave.

-Only pre-registered entries received by July 23, arriving by 9:45 will be judged. Horse entries may arrive as needed.

Judging is prior to the parade with awards given then. Horse plaques are given at sign in.

-Space unavailable at the staging area. NO PARKING FOR VEHICLES NOT IN THE PARADE.

-IT IS PROHIBITED FOR CANDY OR ANY PROJECTILES TO BE THROWN FROM THE PARADE ROUTE OR STAGING AREA DUE TO POTENTIAL INJURY TO CHILDREN OR OTHERS.

-All entries should remain in their assigned position in line.

-All entries should be in keeping with the spirit of the parade. Decoration of commercial entries and others is encouraged.

Complete the enclosed entry form and return it as soon as possible. You will receive a post card within one week of the parade with your entry number on it. Please bring this card to the parade to aid registration. We are charging a \$20 fee for all political campaign related entries. Commercial entries are charged \$10. We are able to put on this parade due to sponsorship and the sale of Old Settlers ribbons, which are available at Pioneer Park. Line up order is determined by when we receive your entry form. Everyone has a good and valid reason for being in front, so in fairness, we can't honor special requests. **If you have any questions please contact:** Bill or Nancy Reilly at 371-2032 or write to:
